Organisation

Hosting and Office Space

We have successfully moved affiliate host to the Open Education Resource Foundation, and have office space at Enspiral.

Staff

I have signed a contract with the OER Foundation at 0.8FTE, which lasts until 30 June 2016. We have also hired Elizabeth Heritage on a 0.4FTE basis until 30 June 2016.

Interns

Law student Victoria Rea has been working with CCANZ for the trimester as part of her internship paper at Victoria University of Wellington. I have also contracted Rachel Mataira for 100 hours of design work, to support the toolkits project.

Funding

Two-year funding agreements with both Land Information New Zealand and InternetNZ have been signed by the OER Foundation. Potential future funding applications are discussed in the funding memo, attached.

Community Calls.

The first CCANZ community call was held on Wednesday 27 August; I will aim to hold these calls every two to three months.

Affiliate Community

I've participated in an international call with new CC CEO Ryan Merkeley, and I have also started joining the regular international Creative Commons Open Education calls.

The Creative Commons Asia Pacific Regional Conference will be held in Seoul, Korea on 15 September. Given the time commitment required, and the reduction in resources available from CC HQ, I've decided not to attend.

Loomio

We have not been very active on Loomio, though will aim to pick this up with the development of the toolkits.

Projects

General: NZCommons

NZCommons was launched in July, and has since published over fifteen pieces by a range of authors.

General: Creative Commons Book

This has not progressed since May, though a draft is largely complete.

Schools: Mix & Mash 2015

It is likely that DigitalNZ, Services to Schools and Network for Learning will run Mix & Mash 2015, with CCANZ acting as a fourth partner.

Schools: Toolkit

Resources are being developed towards a policy toolkit, to be sent to all 500 high schools in either November 2014 or March 2015.

Schools: MoE

I have sent a letter to Nicki Kaye highlighting the Creative Commons recommendations in the *Future Focused Learning Report*.

Research: Open Access Week

With the help of Victoria Rea, CCANZ is planning a national OA Week campaign

Research: Marsden Fund

Matt will present to the Marsden Fund Council in their October meeting.

Heritage: National Digital Forum.

Matt will provide a 101 workshop, and also chair an open content panel with Mark Crookston, Victoria Leachman and Ainslie Dewe.

Indigenous Knowledge: Notice

Now that Susy Frankel has returned from overseas, I have arranged further consultation with both Susy and Aroha Mead.

Indigenous Knowledge: Translation

The translation of the 4.0 licences into te reo Māori is complete, with a period of consultation with HQ and the public to follow before their publication.
