

# Update on CCANZ Public Lead Activities, Sep-Nov 2015

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## Organisation

### *Regional Facilitators*

The regional facilitators have provided two workshops.

### *Funding and Partnerships*

We are meeting the reporting requirements of both InternetNZ and LINZ. Please see the funding update for more details.

### *Victoria University of Wellington*

There has been no progress from Susy Frankel on the application for funding to the Law Commission to fund Creative Commons-related initiatives, and potentially a new CCANZ affiliate.

### *Affiliate Community: CC Summit*

I attended the CC Summit in Korea, October 15-17, and spoke briefly on OERs. I also participated in several affiliate strategy sessions. I argued that the affiliate network needed provide more guidance, share resources and projects more openly, and find a way to collaborate online (rather than in person).

### *Affiliate Community: CC Project Guidance*

Since the Summit, I have agreed to produce guidance resources for affiliates on the kinds of projects they can engage in. I am working with CC Poland and CC South Africa, among others, on these projects.

### *Volunteers*

We have two additional volunteers since the last meeting. We are also participating in the next Data for Good session in Wellington, with the aim of workshopping our existing volunteer plan.

### *Intern*

We are taking an intern from VUW, who will work on issues around the forthcoming copyright review.

### *Loomio*

We have started to report openly in Loomio, with some success. We will continue to add projects to Loomio, and will seek to informally report there at least once a week.

## **Projects**

### *General: Creative Commons Book*

The book is complete, and will be printed shortly.

### *Schools: Cross sector working group*

We have formed a cross-sector working group on Creative Commons licensing in schools, with representatives from NZSTA, NZQA, N4L, PPTA, NZEI, the Education Council and the Ministry of Education. We have had two meetings to date.

### *Schools: New Resources*

We have published a handbook for teachers, which we will look to print in 2016. Our CC Pukeko video for schools is nearing completion. We are also reprinting our existing brochure.

### *Schools: Cable Green Visit*

CC HQ's Cable Green visited New Zealand in October, and attended several meetings in Wellington and Auckland, as well as speaking at ULearn and featuring on Radio NZ's Saturday Morning.

### *Schools: Cross-sector policy toolkits*

We are working with NZSTA to produce a refined sample policy that can be approved and endorsed by other organisations in the sector.

### *Schools: Resource Sprints*

We have launched the OER Sprints, with the website to be launched shortly.

### *Research: Marsden Fund*

At their October meeting, the Marsden Fund Council agreed that the policy is close to ready for review/consultation with some minor amendments.

### *Heritage: Sector Organisations*

Elizabeth attended NDF, and we had a stand at LIANZA

### *Tertiary Education: OER Calls*

I am continuing to work with representatives for the NZ OER community, particularly the folks from Open Otago.

*Journalism: Introductory Resources*

An introductory pamphlet has been completed, and will be distributed at a conference at the end of the year.

*Workshops, Presentations and Conferences 14 August to 16 November*

CCANZ staff and volunteers provided 20 talks and workshops over this period.
