Organisation

Contractors

We have contracted Jem Yoshioka to redesign several resources and our CC road trip posters. We will continue to work with professional designers, like Jem, rather than interns for future design projects.

Intern

We are hosting an intern from Victoria University of Wellington, who will help complete research and writing tasks into open educational resources.

Funding and Partnerships

We are meeting the reporting requirements of both InternetNZ and LINZ. Please see the funding update for more details. We have submitted an application to the second round for UNESCO funding.

Affiliate Community

Matt has completed the 2014 affiliate survey for CCHQ, and is consulting with CC affiliates on developing OER resources.

Projects

General: NZCommons

We have established a sequence of monthly issues, the first of which is open access to scholarly research.

General: OS / OS and Billy Meinke

Billy Meinke, formerly of Creative Commons HQ, has been invited to keynote the Open Source / Open Society conference, April 16-17 in Wellington. We have supported his travel to this conference, and have been recognised as bronze sponsors by the conference organisers.

General: Creative Commons Book

Elizabeth is working with Whitireia Polytechnic's publishing course to publish a book of case studies. Matt has completed an introduction, which will be shared for comment later in the year.

General: Toolkits and New Resources

We have developed a brochure, three sector-specific papers and a range of other resources, to be published at our new resources home, resources.creativecommons.org.nz. We will continue to supplement this page with new resources over the course of the year.

Matt has drafted an introduction to Creative Commons licensing for the Network for Learning website.

Schools: Cable Green and ULearn

Core Education has invited Cable Green to keynote ULearn.

Research: Open Data Management

Matt participated in two sessions on open data management at Lincoln University, at the invitation of Penny Carnaby.

Heritage: March Events

We are holding at least ten events during March, with requests for several more.

Indigenous Knowledge: Notice

There has been no developments since the last meeting. Matt and Karaitiana will work on a consultation strategy when the notice is complete. Susy Frankel has started to draft the notice, and will consult with Aroha Mead and Karaitiana Taiuru during the process, before the draft is released for broader consultation.

Indigenous Knowledge: Translation

The translation of the 4.0 licences into te reo Māori is complete, and HQ have approved the translation for consultation.

Tertiary Education: Declaration and Students' Associations

Matt presented at the NZ Students' Association conference on open educational resources. We are also working with the University of Otago to research student attitudes on textbook prices.

Tertiary Education: Introductory Events

We are holding three open education events with Billy Mienke in Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch, in advance of the OS // OS conference.
